



Deemed Contract Rates

Where Crown Gas and Power remain the registered gas supplier for your premise and no formal contract exists between yourself and us, then we will charge you on a Deemed rate basis.

Deemed rates will continue to be charged until a formal contract is agreed or until you switch to another supplier. Deemed rates are generally more expensive than contracted rates.

As of **12th August 2021**, our Deemed rates are as follows and exclude prevailing VAT and Climate Change Levies (CCL):

Break down of Items

Unit Rate

A unit rate applied in pence/kWh to each actual or estimated unit supplied.

Daily Standing Charge

To cover all third party transmission, distribution and metering costs.

Administrative Charge

To cover additional expense and risks associated with supplying customers on deemed contract terms

Frequently Asked Questions

When will Crown Gas and Power apply Deemed rates?

If no formal contract has ever been agreed with ourselves then you will be placed on our Deemed rates.

Deemed rates will continue to apply until you either enter into a contract with us or switch to another supplier. If you wish to discuss the terms of a new contract then contact our Customer Relation team on hello@crowngas.co.uk or 0161 762 7744.

How will I know when I am being charged Deemed rates?

All customer invoices clearly show the Contract Type. If your Contract Type displays “Deemed” (as shown on the right) then you will know that you are being charged on an Deemed rate basis.

Our Deemed rates will be reviewed regularly.
